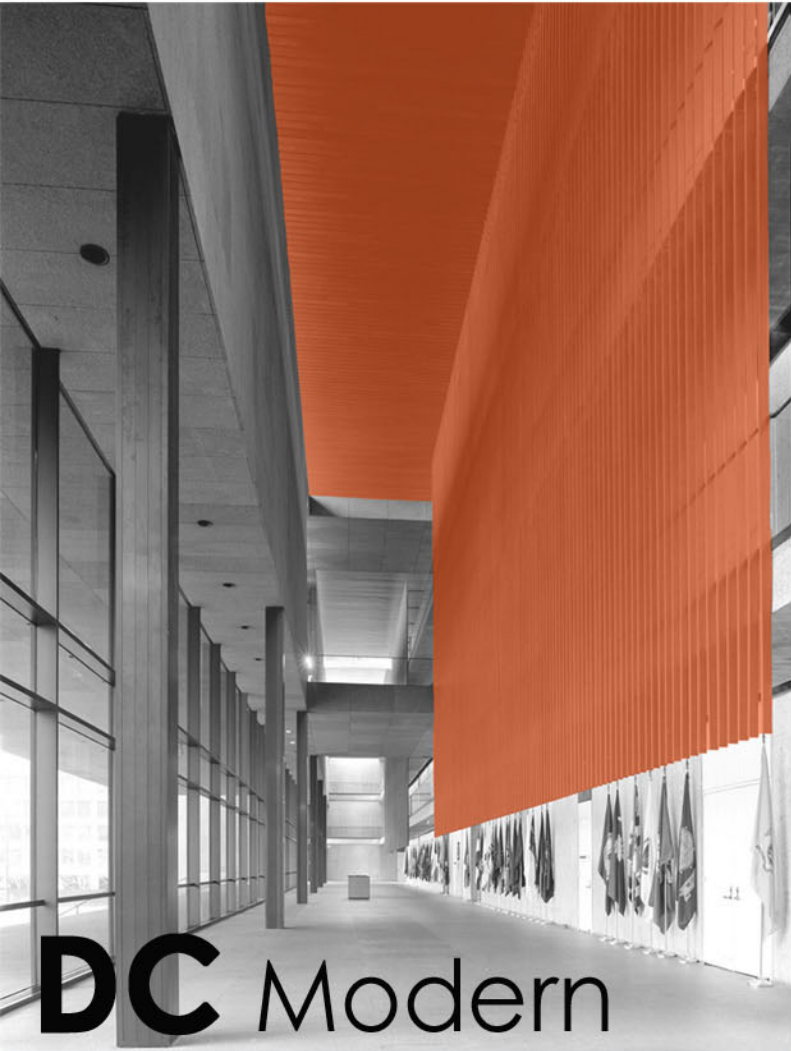


MONUMENTAL MODERN

DCPL teams with GSA to offer a rare visit to and through Victor Lundy's United States Tax Court at 400 2nd Street, NW. Described as Washington's most "monumental" modern masterpiece, the Tax Court was designed in 1966 and constructed in 1974. The exterior and interior of the building remain remarkably intact, a testament to the plans, selection of building materials, and innovative engineering employed by Lundy. The Tax Court is one of Washington's most recent modern landmarks and was listed in the National Register for its exceptional significance in 2008. Participants will marvel at the 4,000-ton cantilevered courtroom block, soaring public hall, elegant bush-hammered concrete interior, teak and hemlock finishes and internal suspended glass bridge system. Don't miss the opportunity to see first-hand this striking and highly sculptural example of mid-century Modernist architecture.
